EVIDENCE TECHNICIAN ELIJAH HARRIS, STAR 15208

On Monday, 31 July 1989, at about 2303 hours, while assigned to the 006th District and on patrol, Officer Elijah Harris was informed by a citizen that a youth had a gun and had fired at him earlier. Based on the information provided, Officer Harris stopped the suspect and was conducting a protective pat down search when the suspect suddenly spun around and produced a weapon from the area of his waistband and fired once, striking the officer in the left upper abdomen. Officer Harris died of his injury on 16 November 1989.
