SERGEANT ALAN J. HAYMAKER, STAR #2532

On Monday, 22 February 2010, Chicago Police Sergeant Alan J. Haymaker #2532 of the 23rd District was fatally injured in an automobile accident while responding to a call of a burglary in progress.

Sergeant Haymaker was appointed to the Chicago Police Department on 05 December 1988. Upon completion of training he was assigned to the 11th District. On 25 June 1992 he was promoted to Field Training Officer. On 16 June 1999 he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant and was assigned to the 15th District. During his 21 year career, Sergeant Haymaker had worked in the 11th District, 15th District, 16th District and most recently the 23rd District.
