

## A NEW POLICE STATION.

### Proposals for the Second Precinct Headquarters.

Proposals were on Saturday opened at the office of the Board of Public Works for the erection of a new police station at the corner of Union and West Madison streets. The order for the erection of this station was passed some weeks since. The accommodations of the West Division police have been for many months past of an exceedingly limited character, and it became apparent that the station at No. 19 North Union street was not only too small, but too inconveniently situated and arranged to meet with the purposes for which it was designed. The order was therefore passed for the construction of a new station, a site having been selected on the corner of West Madison and Union streets. The plans of the structure were prepared in the office of the Board of Public Works, and does not materially vary from that of the new Huron Street Station. Like that this structure is to be four stories in height, of brick, with stone window caps and facing. The internal arrangement will be similar to that of the Huron Street Station. It is to have a depth of eighty feet and a width of forty feet. The following proposals were made for the erection of the building:
