

ARRANGING FOR THE NEW STATION.

Changes Made by Chief McClaughry to Provide for Its Establishment.

Chief McClaughry gave orders yesterday for the establishment of a new police station at the World's Fair grounds, for which a room has recently been leased on Sixty-third street, near Stony Island avenue. The station will be in Inspector Hunt's division, and Lieut. Moore will be in command of it. Patrol-Sergeant Ritchie is promoted to fill the vacant Lieutenancy.
