

JOHN P. REED CHOSEN HEAD OF CHICAGO POLICE OPERATORS

**Man Who Led Fight for Pensions
Unanimously Elected President of
Association—Other Officers Selected.**

John P. Reed of the Canalport avenue station was unanimously elected president of the Chicago Police Operators' association at the annual meeting of that organization in the Masonic temple yesterday. He succeeds John Dixon of the West Chicago avenue station. Other officers elected were:

Vice president, F. J. Sullivan, central station; treasurer, George Nealon, stockyards station; secretary, William Madden, Hinman street station; financial secretary, William Bagley, stockyards station.

The operators are seeking recognition by the police pension board. Their pension bill was defeated in the last legislature and Operators Reed, Sullivan, and Nealon started mandamus proceedings against the pension board. They claim they are as much entitled to pensions as other members of the police department.
