

# 175 YOUNG MEN APPLY TO BE POLICE CADETS

Applications for the police cadet program reached 175 yesterday, with the deadline for applying next Saturday.

Of the applicants, 113 passed a preliminary test and will take more intensive physical and mental examinations. The department will select 100 young men for the program.

Applicants must be between 17 and 19 years old, and attend college after their graduation from high school in June. They must be in the upper half of their graduating class.

## Take Police Exam

Cadets will do clerical police work 40 hours a week, arranged to fit their college studies of six semester hours.

The cadets, when they reach 21 can take the police examination and join the force if they qualify.

Cadet salaries will start at \$4,074 a year, and increase to \$4,710 after 30 months. The youths will wear special uniforms and shields, and will not have any powers of arrest. They will not be allowed to carry guns.

## Other Training Planned

In addition to doing clerical work, the cadets will receive in-service police training.

Applications will be taken thru Saturday at the information desk in the lobby of police headquarters, 1121 S. State st. The desk is open from 8:30 a. m. to 4:30 p. m.
