# Head of new police district named

CAPT. WILLIAM L. Olsen Jr., a Chicago policeman for 25 years, has been named commander of the new Grand Central District on the Far West Side.

Police Supt. Richard J. Brzezczek announced the appointment Tuesday. Olsen, 52, will assume his new post Thursday.

The new police district, with headquarters at 5555 W.

Grand Ave., encompasses parts of the present Austin and Shakespeare Districts and is bounded by Belmont and Central Park Avenues, Division Street, and the city limits on the west.

It also will be the new home of the Area 5 Detective Division, now at the Shakespeare police station.
