

Mayor to dedicate new police station

Mayor Harold Washington will dedicate the new Shakespeare District police station at 11 a.m. Monday.

The \$6.5 million building, located at 2150 N. California Ave., has been empty since it was completed last June. The delay in occupancy was caused by the city's failure to pay the building contractor, who refused to tell city workers how to operate the building's sophisticated computer-controlled heating system until he was paid.

The old district station at 2138 N. California Ave. is to be torn down and replaced by a parking lot.
