As a businessman and member of the bar I hope that your statement of yesterday is a repudiation of your "shoot to kill" order and that you will withdraw it. I protest that order as inflammatory, incitive to violence, and unlawful. It authorizes summary execution for non-capital offenses, on mere suspicion, without benefit of trial by judge and jury. No action could be better calculated to drive a deeper wedge between the races or to heat up a long hot summer, when a healing of the wounds, not a reopening, is needed. Excessive use of force could transform disorder into insurrection and reduce Chicago to cinders. Christianity, which you profess, places a greater value on life than property. Superintendent Conlisk should therefore be praised, not censured, for his restraint. I urge revocation of your order in favor of the "last resort" policy of the Army, National Guard, and FBI, and practice of the humanity of Mayor Lindsay as opposed to the irresponsibility of Governors Wallace and Maddox. The political and business communities, by dereliction of leadership in removing the social causes of the disturbances, racial discrimination and the ghetto, bear primary responsibility for them.
