CROSSING GUARD EVELYN DESPENZA

All members of the Chicago Police Department are saddened by the death of Crossing Guard Evelyn Despenza, killed in the line of duty on 27 October 1986.

While working her crossing at 92nd Street and Jeffery Avenue, Despenza had stepped off the curb to assist a student when she was struck by an auto and fatally injured. Despenza, 73, had been a crossing guard for 33 years.

As superintendent, I urge all officers and crossing guards of the Department to join me in uniform to pay respect at the funeral services.
