RELATED DIRECTIVES **General Order:** Department Awards

**I. PURPOSE**

This directive:

- A. establishes the Crime Reduction Award 2009.
- B. outlines the eligibility requirements and procedures for obtaining the award.

**II. GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Crime Reduction Award 2009:

- A. is an award granted to any sworn/civilian Department member on active duty status during the year 2009, a year in which violent crime took a dramatic drop primarily due to the unified efforts implemented by the Chicago Police Department. This award is in recognition of service of its members.

- B. ribbon bar will be issued to eligible sworn Department members.

**NOTE:** The ribbon bar is worn on the uniform after the Crime Reduction Award (2004).

- C. certificate of recognition and a lapel pin will be issued to all eligible Chicago Police Department civilian members.

**III. AUTHORIZATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS**

- A. The Command Staff Member, Human Resources Division, will determine the timing and procedures for the issuance of the Crime Reduction Award 2009.
- B. Retired Department members who are eligible for this award may contact the Human Resources Division to receive the award.
- C. Family members of deceased Department members eligible for this award may contact the Human Resources Division to receive a member's award.
- D. All requests for a Crime Reduction Award 2009 submitted under Items III-B or III-C of this directive are subject to approval by the Command Staff Member, Human Resources Division.
