I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this notice is to inform Department members of the establishment of a Chaplains Unit within the Office of the Superintendent to minister to the spiritual and moral needs of members and their families.

II. CHAPLAINS UNIT

A. The Chaplains Unit is located in the Timothy J. O'Connor Training Center. Any active Department member or member of his/her family desiring the services of the Chaplains Unit may contact their office between 0800-1700 hours, Monday through Friday, by telephoning 744-8458, or Pax 9-4259, or by contacting Operations Command (744-6301, or Pax 0-301), during non-business hours.

B. The Chaplains Unit will:

1. develop programs and offer opportunities for education, growth and improvement in the areas of ethics, morality and personal and family life.
2. conduct religious services for Department members as needed by represented denominations.
3. be available for personal and family counseling, and be familiar with referral procedures and resources.
4. represent the Department at certain gatherings and functions.
5. provide for the individual needs of hospitalized members and family needs of deceased members upon request.
