RELATED DIRECTIVES

DEPARTMENT SPECIAL ORDER: Differential Response - Call Back Program.

RESCINDS

I. Purpose

This amendment announces implementation of a pilot program, to be conducted within the 005th police district, wherein members of the Chicago Housing Authority Police Department (CHAPD) will:

- A. be equipped with and operate Chicago Police Department (CPD) Zone 9 police radios.
- B. respond to radio assignments for police service which originate from within the Altgeld Gardens Housing Development and are assigned to them via the Chicago Police Department Communication Operations Section (COS).

II. GENERAL INFORMATION

- A. Effective 19 October 1992, at 0800 hours, a pilot program will commence in which the COS will dispatch calls for service to CHAPD personnel assigned to the Altgeld Gardens Housing Development.
- B. CHAPD personnel will be responsible for conducting the preliminary investigation and the disposition of all Radio Assignments dispatched to them.
- C. Headquarters for the CHAPD during this program will be located at 901 East 131st Street; telephone number for this location will be 821-4007 or 821-4013.
- D. The CHAPD will be responsible for answering calls for police service within the following boundaries:
 - 1. 130th Street on the North.
 - 2. 134th Street on the South.
 - 3. St. Lawrence Avenue on the West.
 - 4. The Calumet Expressway on the East.
- E. The CHAPD will be assigned radio call numbers from the COS in the 2800 series (i.e., CHAPD beat cars will be 2841 through 2844, Supervising Sergeants' beat will be 2840 and foot posts will have four digits and a letter such as 2841-A).
- F. Assignment of either CPD or CHAPD units to radio assignments within the area of the pilot program will remain with the COS.
- G. Existing COS procedures relative to the Alternate Response Program (Call - Back) will remain in effect during this pilot program.
- H. CPD units will continue to be assigned to Radio Assignments within the Altgeld Gardens Housing development based upon the need for police service and they will receive, respond to and be responsible for such radio assignments.
- I. This pilot program does not affect the current beat structure or the patrol responsibilities of the 005th District.
- J. In the event any other Department directive contains guidance which appears to be in conflict with the provisions of this amendment, the procedures contained herein will take precedence and be followed throughout the period of the pilot program.
