SUBJECT: Canine Patrol Section

I. PURPOSE

This order establishes the Canine Patrol Section as part of the Task Force.

II. ORGANIZATION

Pending further expansion of the Canine Patrol Section, men undergoing training as well as those assigned to actual patrol will all be under the direction of the sergeant in charge of the Canine Patrol Section.

The Canine Training School will be located at 7900 South County Line Road, LaGrange, Illinois and will be utilized in the training of newly acquired animals and dog-handler candidates, in-service training of patrol teams and the screening and medical examination of all dogs assigned to the unit. Screening of dogs and medical examinations will be under the supervision of the Canine Patrol Section veterinarian.

III. EFFECTIVE DATE

This order is effective 1 July 1961.
