DEPARTMENT GENERAL ORDER NO. 61-84

SUBJECT: District Re-designation, District Boundary Re-alignment, and Police Area Organization and Operation

I. PURPOSE

- A. The purpose of this order is to:
  - 1. Re-designate district numbers,
  - 2. Provide for the re-alignment of district boundaries,
  - 3. Designate newly numbered districts within Police Areas.
- B. Paragraphs A and B of Section II in the above Department General Orders, which refer to area boundaries, are rescinded.

II. DISTRICT NUMBER RE-DESIGNATION

The number designation of the existing 21 police districts is changed as follows:

III. DISTRICT BOUNDARY RE-ALIGNMENT

- A. On the effective date of this order certain district boundaries will be altered to change area responsibility of some districts.
- B. Re-alignment of district boundaries will be in accordance with the 21 district maps distributed by the Planning Division.
- C. Supervisory personnel will insure that proper coverage is maintained in those areas of the city where the police responsibility is transferred to another district by reason of boundary re-alignment.

IV. POLICE AREA ORGANIZATION AND OPERATION

A. On the effective date of this order police districts:

1. 1, 2, and 21 will comprise the 1st Area.
2. 3, 4, 5, and 6 will comprise the 2nd Area.
3. 7, 8, and 9 will comprise the 3rd Area.
4. 10, 11, 12, and 13 will comprise the 4th Area.
5. 14, 15, 16, and 17 will comprise the 5th Area.
6. 18, 19, and 20 will comprise the 6th Area.

B. Area coverage of field service supporting units will be adjusted to conform to the re-aligned boundaries of districts and areas (Detective, youth, traffic).

C. Except as provided in the several sections of this order, organization and operation of the department will continue in accordance with existing orders.

This order is effective 0001, Monday, 18 December 1961.
