
Addendum 2B, Item VI-E-2 is amended and will read as follows:

2. A sworn member whose body armor is unavoidably damaged in the line of duty may seek the temporary loan of body armor by submitting to Operations Command, a To-From-Subject report and copies of related documents, approved by the member's unit/watch commander.

Addendum 2B, Item X-M is amended and will read as follows:

M. Uniformed sworn members or uniformed civilian members will not wear any of the following items at any time while on duty; sworn members assigned to citizen's dress will not wear any of the following items while on duty, unless expressly authorized by the member's unit commanding officer of exempt rank:

1. facial ornamentation/jewelry.
2. earrings or ear ornamentation.
3. any visible neck-chain, medal, medallion or necklace.
4. any visible ankle or wrist bracelet. A bracelet containing medical information may be worn.
5. more than three finger rings.
6. any unauthorized flag, insignia or pin.
