It has been brought to my attention by the five deputy superintendents that one of your major concerns is that you run the risk of having your benefits diminished without a contract.

This is my concern as well as yours because the benefits that I receive are the same benefits that you receive.

I have discussed this issue with the Mayor. I have recommended to her that if police officers choose the "No Single Representative" position the Mayor should go forward and override this concern by introducing an ordinance before the City Council which would lock-in all of the benefits which you are currently receiving and continue to make it possible for you to receive additional benefits.

The Mayor has been very receptive to my recommendation and has given me the commitment that she is prepared to go ahead with the introduction of such an ordinance if the alternative that you select is the "No Single Representative" position.

I again assure you that during my tenure as your Superintendent I will endeavor to secure for you the best benefits possible.
