The City of Chicago offers a valuable benefit package that provides for the well being of all police officers and their family members.

I know we are all interested in these benefits, but we may have some questions or need more detailed explanation.

Beginning this month and continuing through the end of 1990, the Chicago Police Department will make available one-on-one interviews for all police officers so that you can have the opportunity to review the newly negotiated benefit program with trained representatives. Thirty minute meetings will be scheduled for you during your work shift. I urge each of you to attend the personal session which will be scheduled for you so that you will have a clear understanding of all of the benefits.

Representatives conducting the meetings will use a lap-top computer to provide you with information on the following:

- *An explanation of your medical, dental and vision coverage.

- *A personalized projection of your pension benefits.

- *An explanation of the basic and revised optional term life insurance plans, and

- *An opportunity to enroll in a new optional Universal Life program.

Following your meeting, you will receive a personalized benefit statement and brochure which you can take home to share with your family.

Benefit meetings are being scheduled during your working hours to avoid disruption of your normal duties. We suggest you prepare yourself for the meeting by reading the information that will be sent to you prior to the meeting and that you promptly return to your job following the session.
