Police Entrance Exam

The 2006 Police Entrance Exam is coming up Feb. 18-19, 2006 and we are calling on the best and the brightest to step up and take the challenge.

Applications will be available beginning Nov. 28 thru Dec. 11 at all Chicago Public Libraries, Malcom X College, Wright College, and Daley College. Applicants can also apply on the city's website at www.cityofchicago.org/personnel. A link to the CPD website will also be there.

What's new this year, is that applicants can take the exam online under the watchful eye of a monitor at any of the three designated City Colleges. The pen and paper option will also be available for those who prefer the traditional method.

We are also offering the exam in May, August and November 2006, allowing more flexibility for those needing options should they miss an exam date.
