CHICAGO POLICE DEPARTMENT E-MAIL

As electronic mail, or e-mail, has become one of the most widely used methods of communications in the world, the Chicago Police Department is now able to provide e-mail accounts to all sworn and civilian members, regardless of rank. This makes the Chicago Police Department the largest police department in the nation to provide e-mail accounts to all members.

Department members are encouraged to utilize this technology to collaborate and share authorized information with law enforcement colleagues as well as members of the public, including residents, businesses, community organizations, religious institutions, and schools.

Department members will be able to access e-mail 24 hours a day, from any Department computer through the intranet home page as well as any other computer with internet access, through a secure portal at <HTTPS://WEBMAIL.CHICAGOPOLICE.ORG>.

To provide Department members with greater ease of access to information, e-mail will be integrated with various CLEAR processes, including Court Notifications.

All Department members, including those with existing Department e-mail accounts, will be required to agree to a new E-mail Use Policy. To do this, log on to CLEAR via the Department Intranet. Once you read and acknowledge the Use Policy, you will be provided instructions on how to access your Department E-mail.

Providing e-mail access to all members of the Department is another step in our commitment to providing members of the Chicago Police Department with the tools that they need to do their jobs effectively.
