Killed in Line of Duty



POLICE OFFICER FRED ECKLES JR., STAR 13561

All members of the Chicago Police Department are deeply saddened by the tragic and untimely death of Police Officer Fred Eckles Jr. Officer Eckles, assigned to the 6th District Tactical Unit, was fatally wounded in the direct performance of duty on 17 January 1984. Officers Eckles, while he and members of his unit were attempting to serve a search warrant, was fatally wounded in the exchange of gunfire. This day will be long remembered by the men and women of the Chicago Police Department as a day that another of our outstanding officers paid the supreme sacrifice. As Superintendent, I urge all members of the Department to join me in uniform in paying respect to our fallen comrade at the wake and funeral services.

Funeral arrangements are as follows:

- Visitation: Blake - Lamb Funeral Chapel, 10456 S. Western Ave., Friday, 20 January 1984, 1200 to 2200 hours.
- Memorial Service: The Chapel, Friday, 20 January 1984, 1930 hours
- Funeral: Christ Bible Center, 134 East 111th Street, Saturday 21 January 1984 at 1300 hours. Body will lie in state at church for one hour prior to service.
- Interment: Cedar Park Cemetery, 12540 S. Halsted, Calumet Park, Illinois
