On 7 November 1994, a car bomb was detonated in front of 1734 W. Grand Ave., the Hell's Henchman Motorcycle Club.

Officers are urged to use extreme caution when coming into contact with suspicious devices or containers, i.e. fire extinguishers, pipes, and/or unmarked containers. Caution should also be exercised when approaching vehicles, especially stolen vehicles, when parked in the vicinity of locations frequented by motorcycle gangs.

Continued violent acts of this nature are possible. Law Enforcement personnel are advised when coming into contact with suspect motorcycle groups, that the subjects may be ARMED and could be considered DANGEROUS.
