ARRESTED, SHE ASKS \$20,000.

Woman Sues Two Detectives Who Acted Without a Warrant.

Detectives John Quinn and **Joseph D. Driscoll** of the Sheffield avenue station are the defendants in a \$20,000 damage suit filed yesterday in the Circuit court by Mrs. Margaretha Schaefer, 1334 Oakdale avenue. According to N. A. Kaufmann, counsel for the plaintiff, she was arrested without a warrant by the defendants last June and locked up in the police station more than fifteen hours. Mrs. Schaefer is 62 years old.

The defendants, it is said, had a warrant for the arrest of Mrs. Schaefer's son, and when she objected to his arrest, the detectives are alleged to have placed her in a patrol wagon and locked her up on a charge of disorderly conduct. She was discharged by a police magistrate.
