



**ITEM 2: UNIT ASSIGNMENT DESIGNATOR - ALTERNATE**

**DESIGN:** One-piece design concept incorporating both the wording and overall appearance of the integrated prescribed unit assignment designator and prescribed Reeves nameplate.

**MATERIALS:** Flat stock metal or plastic which closely resembles the color and finish of the prescribed Reeves Co. nameplate (Specifications #14.0113).

**CONSTRUCTION:** This alternate item must appear as a one-piece body manufactured of an approved material. As stipulated in the material portion of this specification, the body face must appear to the viewer as resembling the color and finish of the Reeves Company nameplate.

The item will be dimensionally identical (length and width) to that of the unit assignment designator and nameplate when they are integrated (2-1/4" x 1"). Thickness will not exceed .062", and all four corners may have a radii which does not exceed 1/8".

The item face will contain applicable wording of the same type and size as the prescribed nameplate and prescribed unit assignment designator. The item face will be divided into two equal parts (upper and lower sections), by a horizontal line that divides the item's one inch face in half. The line shall not exceed 1/16" in breadth.

The upper section (nameplate), will contain the wearer's engraved correct last name. The lower section (assignment), will contain wording of the wearer's current engraved assignment (see item 1 of this specification for applicable assignment wording, etc.). All engraved wording and the engraved horizontal line must be finished in the same color as the prescribed Reeves Co. nameplate (black ink or lacquer).

A set of two plain pins/clutches or threaded pins/spin nuts are authorized as fastening assemblies. These fastening assemblies will be similar to the Reeves Co. nameplate. The pins or threaded pins will be positioned on the back of the item body on a parallel plane 1/4" below the upper horizontal (length) edge of the item. The pins or threaded pins will be affixed and centered on the parallel plane 1-5/8" apart, center to center.

- AUTHORIZATIONS/RESTRICTIONS:**
1. Alternate unit assignment designators/nameplates may be substituted for the prescribed nameplate and prescribed unit assignment designator.
  2. This item will be affixed to the member's outer garment (excluding rainwear) when the prescribed uniform is worn.
  3. This item will not be concealed by any means.
