MATERIAL: Metal
CONSTRUCTION/
COLOR: Five-point stellate shape.

Color:

White Metal for the following:

1. Sworn members:
 - a. Police officers
 - b. Sergeants
 - c. Lieutenants
 - d. Captains
2. Civilian Members:
 - a. Recruit investigators
 - b. O.P.S. investigators

Yellow Metal for the following:

- 1 Sworn members:
 - a. Inspectors
 - b. Legal officers
 - c. Exempt members
2. Civilian Members:
 - a. Chaplains
 - b. Chief police surgeon
 - c. Police surgeons (occupational health physicians)
 - d. Exempt members

Design: A plated, embossed, and properly finished identification designator, featuring the Seal of the City of Chicago, a Department identifier, a rank/position identifier, and in the case of white metal stars (for sworn members), copper numerals. The star will be equipped with a vertically positioned hinged safety catch type pin on its undersurface.

- AUTHORIZATIONS/
1. When assigned to uniform duty, the star will be worn in the position and manner prescribed by Department directives.
 2. When assigned to citizen's dress, the star will be carried upon the person during a member's tour of duty.
